- **3.** What evidence pointed towards an "in-valid" as the murder suspect?
- **4.** If you have a child someday, would you choose the gender and/or some of the traits for your child if you could? Explain why or why not.
- 5. At the end of the film, we find out the doctor knew about Vincent all along.
 - a) Why didn't the doctor expose Vincent and turn him in? Would you have? Why or why not?
